INSPECTOR NOTES: Jarred, unlabeled, undated salsa from an unlikely approved source used in establishment. All foods must have proper licensing process from approved source. *COS, discarded.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Raw eggs held over RTE food. *COS RTE food discarded.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Multiple food items stored without made and discard date.

37: 3-305.11: N: Food not protected from contamination during storage.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Stew packaging comprimised allowing for contamination. Use better wrap and do not "nest" product. *COS

39: 3-304.14.(B).(1): N: Wiping cloths used for wiping counters and other equipment surfaces not held between uses in a chemical sanitizer.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Soiled wiping cloth used to wipe counters. All counters must be wiped down with chemical sanitizer and allowed to air dry. *COS

47: 4-602.13: N: Non-food contact surfaces are not cleaned at a frequency necessary to preclude accumulation of soil residues.

INSPECTOR NOTES: Refrigerator and inside dishwasher is unclean. Clean more often and as neccessary.

Following are a few of the major changes: * No Bare Hand Contact with Ready-To-Eat Food. * Establishments must have clean-up procedures for employees to follow following vomiting and diarrheal events. * Date marking of Ready-to-eat potentially hazardous foods.

Violation Correction Timeframe:

Critical violations should be corrected on site, but in any event, within 10 days. The licensee must contact Louis Lachance when the critical violation has been addressed at 207-513-3125 extension 3224 or at llachance@lewistonmaine.gov. Non-critical violations must be corrected within 30 days. Failure to satisfactorily correct these violations before the follow-up inspection may result in enforcement proceedings by the Department to include fines and penalties. License renewals can be denied if violations are not corrected within the noted timeframes.

C= Critical violation and NC= Non-critical violation:

"Critical violation" means a provision of the Food Code that, if in non-compliance, is more likely than other violations to contribute to food contamination, illness or environmental health hazard.

Additional Inspection Fee:

License fees provide for two inspections per year. When additional inspections are required, the Department may charge an additional \$100 fee to cover the costs of each additional inspection or visit.

Document Retention/Posting:

Pursuant to the Maine Food Code, the establishment's current license must be displayed. In addition, a sign or placard must be posted in a conspicuous area notifying consumers that a copy of the most recent inspection report is available upon request. CFPM certificates must be posted in a conspicuous area and must be available to the Department upon request.
