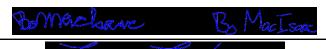

The Maine Food Code was adopted in October of 2013. Please refer to our website for a copy, http://www.maine.gov/healthinspection. Following are a few of the major changes: * No Bare Hand Contact with Ready-To-Eat Food. * Establishments must have clean-up procedures for employees to follow following vomiting and diarrheal events. * Date marking of Ready-to-eat potentially hazardous foods.

Violation Correction Timeframe:

Critical violations should be corrected on site, but in any event, within 10 days. The licensee must contact Louis Lachance when the critical violation has been addressed at 207-513-3125 extension 3224 or at llachance@lewistonmaine.gov. Non-critical violations must be corrected within 30 days. Failure to satisfactorily correct these violations before the follow-up inspection may result in enforcement proceedings by the Department to include fines and penalties. License renewals can be denied if violations are not corrected within the noted timeframes.

C= Critical violation and NC= Non-critical violation:

"Critical violation" means a provision of the Food Code that, if in non-compliance, is more likely than other violations to contribute to food contamination, illness or environmental health hazard.

Additional Inspection Fee:

License fees provide for two inspections per year. When additional inspections are required, the Department may charge an additional \$100 fee to cover the costs of each additional inspection or visit.
